

Buyer's guide / Tool sharpeners

Sharp around the edges

Geoff Hodge looks sharp and checks out a wide range of tool sharpeners available on the market now



There are some garden tools that need a sharp blade to work efficiently, otherwise they can do more damage than good or not perform properly. The obvious contenders are knives, shears, secateurs,

loppers and other pruners. A good, sharp blade will produce a clean cut - essential when pruning plants to ensure the cut heals quickly and prevents disease problems. Less obvious are hoes. When hoeing, the aim is to slice through the weeds' stems at or near ground level with a sharp blade - not bludgeon them to death

with a blunt one! It always amazes me how few people even know about this - let alone carry it out. When I give talks to gardening clubs and ask the audience the question, usually less than 10% of them sharpen their secateurs and even fewer sharpen their hoes. In fact, I met one person who buys a new blade for his

secateurs every year. When asked why, he said to have a sharp blade, obviously! He was amazed that the blade could be sharpened. I've had my current secateurs for more than 18 years and have never replaced the blade; I sharpen it whenever I use them. There are numerous types of sharpeners available.

Carborundum and oil stones have been around forever and anyone that looks after their household or woodworking tools is likely to have one in the shed. But generally they are really quite large and cumbersome and you couldn't carry them around with you when gardening. Now we have a wide range of small, hand-held

sharpeners that are really handy for us gardeners. Some are based on diamond - one of the hardest materials known to man - so are bound to get a good, nice sharp blade. Others use other hard materials, such as tungsten carbide - which is only beaten in hardness by diamond, so again will give a very good blade finish.

Multi-sharp Tools Secateur & Lopper Sharpener

Silicon carbide sharpener. For secateurs, loppers, pruners and knives. Grinding jig locks to blade to ensure sharpening at the correct angle.

Multi-Sharp Tools Shear & Scissor Sharpener

Tungsten carbide sharpener. For scissors and shears. Screws on to a bench or the back of a shed door - screws included.

Both these sharpeners are available as part of a Gardening Tool Sharpening Kit, which also include a sharpener for either cylinder mower or rotary mower blades. The rotary mower sharpener will also sharpen hoes, spades, edging irons and axes.

Comment for both the tools secateur & lopper sharpener and tools shear and scissor sharpener

Neither tool is suited for carrying around while you garden. The sharpening kits are great value for money and suitable for all your garden tools.



Spear & Jackson Razorsharp 6-in-1 Blade Sharpener

Tungsten carbide and aluminium oxide sharpener with different sharpeners for different tools. For knives, scissors, secateurs, loppers and shears. Anti-rust and cleaning, lubricating oil and pad stored in the handle. Plastic body with non-slip grip and built-in finger guard for protection.

- Length 11cm (4 1/4in)
- Price guide £8.49

Very comfortable to use and will get into the tightest space, such as the base of secateur blades. Good hand guard for the squeamish.



Blade-Tech Knife Sharpener

Tungsten carbide sharpener. For knives, scissors, secateurs, loppers, shears, mower blades and scythes. Comes with a canvas belt pouch to protect the sharpener.

- Length 7.5cm (3in)
- Price guide £10

Very handy and small enough to get into the tightest space, such as the base of secateur blades.



Bosmere Sharpening Stone

A two grade sharpening stone for sharpening all types of blades from garden shears, secateurs, chisels, scissors and knives to mowers. Use with household oil for best results.

- Length 19.5cm (7 3/4in)
- Price guide £4.25

Although too large to carry around the garden, this is very good for sharpening a wide range of garden tools, especially larger blades, including shears, hoes and even spades.



Bosmere Multi Sharpener

Tungsten carbide sharpener. For knives, scissors, snips and secateurs. Anti-rust and cleaning, oil wipe pad stored in the handle. Fibreglass reinforced nylon body with built-in plastic finger guard for protection.

- Length 15cm (6in)
- Price guide £6.99

Very comfortable to use and will get into the tightest space, such as the base of secateur blades. Finger guard for the squeamish.



Burgon & Ball Sharpening Steel

The Sharpening Steel is ideal for sharpening medium-sized blades, such as shears.

Burgon & Ball Miniature Sharpening Steel

The Miniature Sharpening Steel is perfect for carrying around the garden to sharpen small knives, secateurs and other small-bladed cutting tools.

Comment for both sharpening steels Good traditional sharpening steels. These are both magnetised, so the fillings stick to the steel rather than remaining on the blade where they are liable to go rusty.

Darlac DP100F & DP100C Diamond Sharpeners

Diamond sharpeners. Plastic handles. Use DP100F (fine) for pruners, knives, small blades and finishing off. Use DP100C (coarse) for shears and axes, roughing in and honing heavier steel blades.

- Length 15cm (6in)
- Price guide DP100F £7.99; DP100C £9.99
- Comment Pocket-sized sharpeners. It's useful having two grades, so you can get a good edge on a wide range of tools. And, considering they're diamond - extremely economical.

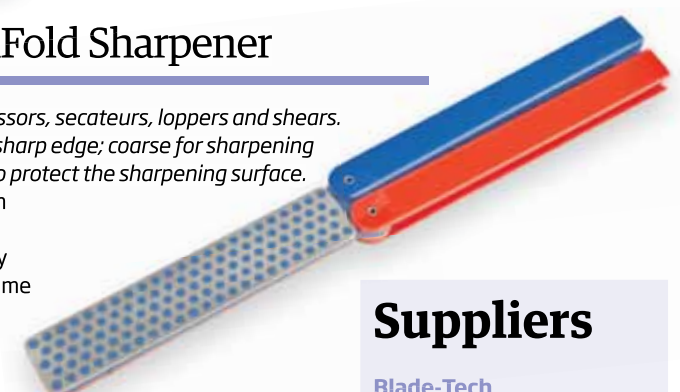

Diamond sharpener. For knives, scissors, secateurs, loppers and shears. Double sided: fine for putting on a sharp edge; coarse for sharpening a neglected edge. Folding handle to protect the sharpening surface.

Diamond sharpener. Made of diamond-coated hardened steel and perfect for the sharpening, strengthening and honing of a wide range of cutting tools.

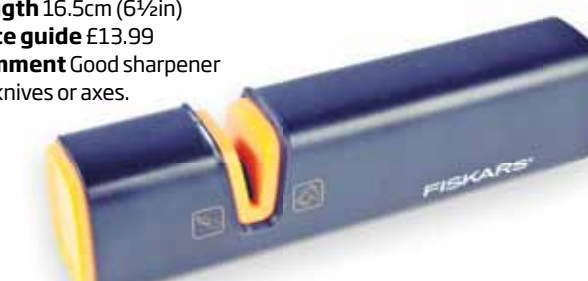
